


JGRAD 博士人材データベース Japan Graduates database

National Institute of Science and Technology Policy (NISTEP) of the MEXT runs Japan Graduates Database (JGRAD). The main purpose of JGRAD is **to survey career paths and opinions** of doctoral human resources in order to formulate support policies.


NISTEP accepts web applications for JGRAD registration from people who entered doctoral course at a member university after FY2014.

Eligible person are **welcome to register with JGRAD and enter your information.**

There are **several advantages for JGRAD registration.**

- 1 JGRAD registrants can join online communities(Slack and Facebook) of doctoral human resources, and exchange information. 
- 2 "Role Model" which can be viewed after logging in to JGRAD, contains useful information for doctoral human resources to consider careers.
- 3 JGRAD is linked to JREC-IN by the Japan Science and Technology Agency (JST), and displays job offer information related to your registered research field.
- 4 Career information and survey responses including free descriptions are reflected in reports published by NISTEP, and contribute to the policy formation.

People who entered doctoral course at JGRAD member universities after FY2014 can join JGRAD at any time by submitting web registration application.

As of January 2024, there are 90 JGRAD member universities. A web list of JGRAD member universities (https://jgrad.nistep.go.jp/about_e/university.html) has links to the web application for each member university.



Doctoral human resources from non-member universities can join JGRAD if MEXT/NISTEP has received consent to join JGRAD after web surveys via universities.

JGRAD asks registrants to revise career information when a registrants complete a doctoral course or change jobs.
